Exciting sports

Soccer is Haiti's passion! Many people tune in to 4VEH daily to hear the latest results. When a longtime ministry friend remembered 4VEH with a gift in their will, in 2015 God added television to 4VEH ministries. We longed to offer soccer broadcasts to reach people who may not tune in for a Bible study.

In 2020, with no internet at the stadium, our team began recording championship games to broadcast a post-game summary. We invested in internet capability at the stadium and in 2021, viewers were thrilled to see 'their teams' live on TV! We pray these broadcasts will attract people who love soccer but have never heard the Gospel, and as they enjoy broadcasts, they will hear about Jesus.

Reaching, teaching, serving

Inspiring documentaries

4VEH documentaries help people to learn more about their communities' historical and cultural richness, and to be challenged and inspired by other people's trials and triumphs.

After producing a series of one hour documentaries in 2020 to celebrate the city of Cap-Haitien's 350th anniversary, in 2021 our team produced documentaries on a cacao (chocolate) growing co-operative celebrating 20 years (pictured above), on national Agriculture and Labor Day events, and a soccer star's testimony, all to educate and inspire viewers.

 840 people shared the live soccer championship final broadcast with their Facebook friends and it reached 53,000 people on just one channel.



Prayer programs mark the beginning, middle and end of each day. The midday program is now a full hour during the week, and two hours on Saturdays. It is broadcast on all 4VEH networks, AM, FM radio, Channel 11 local television, and live streamed on our website, App, Roku, Amazon TV, Apple TV, YouTube and Facebook. The program includes meditation and encouragement from God's Word,

receiving of praise and prayer requests from people calling in or commenting on social media, and taking these items to the Lord in collective prayer. In 2021, even more people joined together in prayer.

In 2020, we enhanced our daily Bible reading on air (so helpful for people who can't read or don't have a Bible) and launched a Bible-In-One-Year reading plan with a daily program and podcast, which in 2021 helped more people discover the whole Bible.

Digital ministry still growing

Our mission is to reach, teach and serve Haitians with the Gospel, wherever they are. Digital ministry connects us with people living outside our terrestrial radio and television broadcast reach to Haitians anywhere in the world with an internet connection!

The Bible & the power of prayer



In 2021, you helped 25 artists and groups to record songs in our studios.

Recording studio ministry

As a recording studio and record label, we serve local Christian artists, (both those debuting their music and more accomplished artists) in recording songs of the highest quality to honor God and bless the body of Christ.

The most popular song ever played on 4VEH is Retire Sandal Ou (Take Off Your Sandals), recorded at 4VEH in the 1970s by church choir Les Séraphins de Fort-Liberté. It became so closely identified with 4VEH that people would go to the market to buy a "Retire Sandal radio" meaning a radio that would play 4VEH. Retire Sandal Ou captures the scene of taking off your sandals in the

presence of a holy God, for 'you're standing on holy ground'.

To celebrate 4VEH's 70th Anniversary in June 2020, several staff members formed the 4VEH band to perform their own cover version of Retire Sandal Ou. Well-known Haitian Christian artists and choirs also contributed songs for the album.

We've missed having visitors on short-term mission teams helping with this outreach (due to travel diffculties to Haiti) but rest assured, your sponsorship of Resounding Hope solar radios/audio Bibles and your prayers continue to reach families living in areas

of deep poverty, without reliable electricity, where many people can't read and Vodou keeps them trapped in fear.

Even with limited access to communities in need because of gang violence and fuel shortages in 2021, our local team and church partners visited and shared the Gospel with 1875 people, including 500 earthquake survivors. Praise the Lord, during these conversations, 270 people came to faith in Jesus.

New FM station for South Haiti

By God's grace, 4VEH was in the right place at the right time to be a voice of hope to suffering people when on August 14, 2021, a massive earthquake devastated southwestern Haiti.

Just months before, in December 2020, 4VEH launched a new FM station in Les Cayes, in time to bless the people of South Haiti with Christmas broadcasts. With basic equipment and a limited schedule of daily broadcasts, the programs were very well received by new listeners.


FROM NEW LISTENER ELIDE:

"As soon as 4VEH came to the south, I felt it was in my heart, because 4VEH programs make a difference in my life.

There's one program that really got my attention - Answers to Family Problems with Pastor Codo & Dr. Myrlande, how husbands and wives should behave with each other. This program stayed in my mind because we don't

get programs like this but 4VEH took the time to think about what people need. God bless you, 4VEH."

After sustaining tower damage from Tropical Storm Elsa in July 2021, the repaired station went back on the air just days before the earthquake.







Haiti's third largest city, Les Cayes, where new 4VEH Cayes/South FM is located, was the closest city to the epicenter and among the worst-hit areas. 4VEH Cayes was the only radio station still broadcasting in Les Cayes immediately after the quake. Praise God that the Gospel continued to fill the airwaves even as the ground shook.

More than 2,000 people died, 12,000 injured, 135,000 homes damaged or destroyed, and one million people experienced very strong or severe shaking. Thank you for your urgent prayers and quick generosity to bring help and hope to earthquake survivors.

We knew we could help people straight away with life-saving information and Christian broadcasts, and launched an emergency appeal to help even more. You and so many other friends gave generously to bless earthquake survivors with news & Gospel broadcasts, food & hygiene kits, tarps for shelter, solar radios to connect them to 4VEH programs and audio Bible,

and mobilized local medical staff and supplies.

Through on-air campaigns called *Ansanm* ak Gran Sid (Together with the Greater South region), you helped mobilize Haitians - listeners, viewers and their families, churches, and organizations – to respond in prayer and generosity to help brothers and sisters in southern Haiti. What a blessing to see the body of Christ respond together.

You blessed earthquake survivors with:

- 207 people trained in evangelism

Broadcasting Stories of Hope

Hundreds of thousands of people heard Merline's interview. Specifically on our Facebook page for Haitians (Radio-Télé 4VEH), her story reached 175,000 people more than 1,600 people liked, commented, or shared this story of God's faithfulness with their own social network.

"God rescued me from among the dead" Merline was busy making breakfast when the ground shook violently from a 7.2 magnitude earthquake 20 miles away.

"I was making soup. I asked one of my children to fetch something in another room, then the earthquake happened."

Merline didn't have time to escape. A wall fell on her and cut her head open as she lost consciousness. Rescuers who pulled her from the rubble thought she was dead but one of her children saw she was still alive.

"I didn't know if I would survive because they laid me with the bodies. But I thank God, He rescued me."

"My daughter was in the house," she says of 6-year-old Parola, her leg bandaged. "It seems the pot of soup fell on her."

Merline said of her neighborhood, "Every home was destroyed, everyone is in the streets. There's not one home still standing.

The rescue team took Merline and two children to a local hospital where her head injury was stitched up, but she needed to go to a bigger hospital for a scan. She just couldn't afford transport there. Suffering dizzy spells and concerned for her children, Merline had no option but to wait for help.

She thanked God for rescuing her from among the dead and thanked 4VEH for the opportunity to share her testimony.

Broadcasts Brought Help

After 4VEH reporter Jimmy's interview with Merline was aired on 4VEH local and national stations and social media platforms, Merline's story gained attention from locals and Haitians further afield, who asked how they could pray and help her.

A few days later, Merline told Jimmy that US troops assisting with relief efforts transported her and her injured children to an emergency field hospital. Praise God!

Merline was just one of thousands of earthquake survivors touched by your prayers and generosity.



Daily news & Gospel broadcasts

Every day, broadcasts in quake zone reach a potential 350,000 people, sharing daily help & eternal hope with survivors, those responding and communities across south Haiti. Programs from our main broadcast center in Cap-Haitian connect people worldwide with updates and the Gospel.

On air when the ground shook

When the earthquake hit, sports reporters Jimmy and William were live on air in our Cap-Haitien studios for the Saturday morning sports program. They felt the ground shake 120 miles away from the epicenter. They took shelter and returned on the air minutes later. Our team began adapting programs to include reports from earthquake-hit areas, interviews with survivors and focused prayer for brothers and sisters in southwestern Haiti.











Medical clinics

We focused on supporting local health workers to offer services to people in remote areas who were unable to access care elsewhere. People were treated for minor earthquake injuries and chronic problems like high blood pressure, diabetes

Local medical teams treated 897 patients, including children.

Evangelism & solar radios

Training believers in evangelism and distributing solar radios/audio Bibles through our Resounding Hope project is a core 4VEH ministry. This training will continue to motivate local churches in their outreach to neighbors. We knew earthquake survivors desperately needed a way to listen to God's Word and Christian broadcasts as well as news and updates.



immediately donated 1,000 'emergency' solar radios tuned to 4VEH (without audio Bible) which were given to people, with the Gospel message, in Les Cayes. Pastor Hérode Pierre, who leads our evangelism and radio outreach, trained 207 leaders in evangelism and led them door-to-door. Another 400 solar radios/audio Bibles have been given to families since. In total, 1,400 solar radios will continue to minister to people on a daily basis. Each radio serves about six people.

Reporting from quake zone

We sent reporters to many remote locations to highlight people's needs in neglected areas.

By supporting these efforts, you helped grieving, homeless families with urgent needs like food and shelter. You helped people in Les Cayes city and surrounding areas to find hope in Jesus, grow as disciples and live out their faith right where they were, even in the midst of a terrible disaster.

With a small emergency fund already in country, we quickly transferred funds to purchase food and hygiene items as close to the quake zone as possible, avoiding the security risks of transporting goods through gang-controlled areas in Port-au-Prince, and injecting much-needed income back to quake-hit local businesses.

Families received Food & Hygiene Kits and Tarps for Shelter

Haiti is one of the hungriest nations on earth. Life was very hard for people in this region hard-hit by hurricanes. With so many homes destroyed and roads blocked in the quake, families desperately needed food.

Five days after the earthquake, we began distributing Food Kits to survivors like Skenlove (in red shirt, above). Hundreds of families received a Food Kit, with rice, spaghetti, beans & other necessities purchased locally, given with a Bible message to encourage people; and/or a Hygiene Kit, with soap and other essentials; and/or a tarp for shelter to provide temporary relief from the sun and rain. Our team discovered that even for people whose homes were still standing, many were terrified to sleep indoors because of so many aftershocks.

Thanks to your generosity and local business *Paulos Group*, we ordered tarps delivered directly to our Cayes team who distributed 1,569 tarps to families in need.

You encouraged earthquake survivors like Bonel (pictured above and on front cover) through broadcasts of hope, gifts of food and shelter, and Christian love. Bonel told our news crew:

"Thank you for helping me in the disaster I endured. My house was destroyed and 4VEH helped me. I received a tarp, some food. Thank you. I give thanks to God for protecting my boy, who was at my neighbor's when the house fell. He came out of it safe and sound, not even a piece of concrete fell on him!"

Billions of dollars have been spent over decades to try and pull Haiti out of extreme poverty, corruption, injustice, political turmoil, yet it remains a country, a people, in great need. We believe the only way to see lasting change in Haiti is through the transforming work of the Gospel of Jesus in the hearts and lives of Haiti's people. While many people live in spiritual bondage, without ever hearing the Gospel or having an opportunity to know the hope of Christ themselves, we press on together, counting on your partnership in this sacred responsibility of serving God and the Haitian people through media.

REPLACE TOWER

With huge price increases for cement, steel and shipping, it's costing more than budgeted, but without the tower, hundreds of thousands of people would have no daily lifeline of Gospel hope.

4VFH transmitted its first broadcast on shortwave on 2 June 1950, after American missionary G. T. Bustin was obedient to God's call to begin a radio station in Cap-Haitien, Haiti and call it 'La Voix Evangélique d'Haïti' (The Evangelistic Voice of Haiti).

In 2019, 4VEH became an independent 501(c) (3) nonprofit organization, separating from One Mission Society by mutual agreement to allow both ministries to more fully pursue God's calling while continuing to partner together.

4VEH also partners with global media ministry TWR and others to advance God's kingdom together. We thank you for your commitment to serving God and the people of Haiti through media as you partner with 4VEH.
